

Keep Cheese Longer





Our FBI firearms instructor and a sergeant from the Shelby County Sheriff's Office prepared the gun for shipping to the FBI lab for processing it for bullet comparison and fingerprints.

An alert went out for Eric Starvo Galt, registered at the motel driving a white Mustang. The FBI lab, checking for fingerprints, determined the prints were of James Earl Ray.

A new alert was put out nationwide for James Earl Ray, because it was determined that he was an escapee from prison and now a suspect in the murder of Dr. King.

Two months later, James Earl Ray was apprehended at London Heathrow Airport. Ray pleaded guilty to King's murder and was sentenced to 99 years in prison. Ray died in prison in 1997 at the age of 70.

A Connection With Nature Nurtures You, Body and Spirit

Some celebs put their money where their mouth is when it comes to protecting Mother Nature. The Leonardo DiCaprio Foundation has focused on the health of oceans, rainforests and Antarctica and access to clean water since 1998. That's a health-boost for all of us.


Plants, herbs and minerals have the power to protect and heal, and simply being "in nature" can transform a person's physical and emotional wellbeing by lowering stress and improving cognition. Unfortunately, what one naturalist calls "nature deficit disorder" is a growing problem for urban kids and adults. Only 50% of the public say they've taken a hike in a natural setting in the past year, according to Pew Research. That's just one time in one year.

What's needed for optimal benefit? Three or four times a week, you need to work in a garden or yard, stroll in a park, bike by a river, gaze at the sky and birds, marvel at the weather. Every day is even better, according to Texas A&M's Center for Health & Nature. Research backs that up: A 2019 study in Current Directions in Psychological Science found that being able to access nature improves cognitive flexibility, working memory and focus. But even bringing green plants into your home or office has been shown to help reduce your stress response.
