



Chocolate Chip Pound Cake

- 1 (18.25-oz) pkg yellow cake mix with pudding
- 1 (3.9-oz) pkg chocolate instant pudding mix
- ¹/₂ c sugar
- ³/₄ c vegetable oil
- ³/₄ c water
- 4 large eggs
- 1 (8-oz) carton sour cream
- 1 (6-oz) pkg semisweet chocolate morsels
- Powdered sugar, sifted

Preheat oven to 350°F. Combine first three ingredients in a bowl, stirring with wire whisk to remove large lumps. Add oil and next three ingredients to mixture, stirring until smooth. Stir in chocolate morsels. Pour batter into a greased and floured 12-cup bundt pan. Bake at 350°F for 1 hour or until a wooden pick inserted in cake comes out clean. Cool in pan on wire rack for 10 minutes; remove cake from pan, and cool cake completely on wire rack. Sprinkle with powdered sugar. Yields: one 10 inch cake. - Enjoy!



Our mom and dad passed away several years ago, so I feel like this leaves me to be the big brother and parent at the same time. I'm not sure how to help him. Can you give me some advice, please? — Andy Dear Andy

You're a good and caring big brother to be concerned and want to help. And it's a tough situation for you, especially with your parents no longer in the picture.

When I help people on my show, I have the benefit of them calling in and actually wanting help. These folks care about what I think, and in most cases, they realize things aren't working for them. I don't just walk up to people and say, "You know, what you're doing is really stupid. Let me fix you." I think that's kind of the situation you're in right now. So, before anything else, I'd begin to pray for him. Ask God to bring people into his life who will have a positive impact on him.

One of the worst things about these situations is watching people you love do bad things to themselves and the people around them. Honestly, I don't know there's really a lot you can do without becoming the enemy to some degree. You can always try to hold him to a higher standard, and refuse to tolerate immature, irresponsible behavior when you're around him. You might even look for opportunities to use yourself as an example. I'm not talking about puffing out your chest and pretending to be perfect. I'm just saying maybe point out areas in your life where you made mistakes in the past and how you fixed the problems. But going out and trying to actively intervene in his life without permission, or shaming him in hopes it'll make him grow up and be a man, would probably do more harm than good.

Approach him in a gentle, caring way. Again, not like some know-it-all, but just let him know you care and you're there to help if he's having difficulties. Take him out to lunch once in a while, or invite him over, and let him know you're there for him if he needs to talk.

And remember what I said earlier about prayer? Bringing God into the equation is never a bad idea. — Dave

It comes as no surprise that pregnant women - and all the rest of us - should avoid ultraprocessed foods that are loaded with unhealthy fats, excess salt and sugar and a slew of coloring, preservatives, texturizers and other additives that Mother Nature never put into whole, healthy foods. But there's a new twist from researchers at the University of Washington. In their study published in Environment International, they're sounding an alarm about the dangers posed by the phthalates in the plastic packaging that most highly processed foods come in.

Turns out phthalate-containing plastics can leach into food from the wrapping and packaging and even from plastic gloves worn by fast-food handlers. The phthalates then travel through mom's bloodstream into the fetus's circulatory system. There, they increase the risk for everything from low birth weight and preterm birth to disorders such as autism and ADHD.

The researchers tracked more than 1,000 pregnant women for five years. They found that, on average, ultra-processed foods made up more than a third of the participants' diet and every 10% greater amount of ultra-processed foods that a pregnant woman ate led to a 13% higher concentration of one of the most common and harmful phthalates in a pregnant woman's urine.

To protect your fetus — and yourself — the smart move is to stick with minimally or unpackaged fresh fruits and vegetables and whole grains and to avoid plastic-packaged desserts and treats and prepared meals, fresh or frozen.
