She'll Be Just Fine

Dear Dave,

My mom is 76, and the only debt she has is about \$60,000 left on her mortgage. She has \$600,000 in retirement accounts, plus a long-term care insurance policy. But she has just \$25,000 in a money market account with check-writing privileges for everyday bills and purchases. To be honest, this worries me. She has always lived within her means, so am I wrong to be concerned? She has also been talking about paying off her mortgage, and I'm not sure how I feel about that, either. I'd love your opinion. —Kelly

You sound surprised that she'd still be in the stock market at her age. In my mind, that's not a bad thing at all. It might not be what the typical financial planner would tell you to do, because for the most part they'll try to get you to be super-conservative with your money as you get older. But from the way you've described things, it sounds like she's not planning on using this money, but using the income from the money. If that's the case, she won't whittle it all down to nothing. So, if she's in good mutual funds—not single stocks—I think she'll be just fine.

Now, let's talk about the mortgage. I would absolutely recommend she go ahead a pay it off. If she can do that at age 76 and still have \$540,000 left, that's the way to go. Let's pay off the house, and then she can start taking her income off a percentage of the remainder. She won't need much with the house payment out of the way, because she won't be sending money to the bank to pay the anymore. — Dave





Crunchy Cabbage Salad





Reducing the risk of cardiovascular problems in Type 2 diabetes Around 30% of people with Type 2 diabetes have cardiovascular disease (CVD). But that's just what's been diagnosed. A new study shows that another third of adults in the U.S. with Type 2 diabetes may have symptomless or undetected CVD. That may explain why more than 70% of

people with Type 2 diabetes die from cardiovascular causes. One of the big culprits is high blood pressure: Around 66% of adults with diabetes have blood pressure greater than 130/80 or use prescription medications for high blood pressure. The good news is you can reduce the risks of developing and dying from CVD if you have Type 2 diabetes by adopting intensive blood

pressure control.

A study in The New England Journal of Medicine found that when participants aimed for a standard systolic (the upper number) blood pressure of 140, they were far more likely to experience a nonfatal stroke or heart attack, be hospitalized for heart failure and die from CVD than the folks aiming for a systolic number of 120. So, talk to your doc about how to

Other ways to reduce your CVD risk if you have diabetes: Aim for a healthy weight; get 300 minutes of exercise weekly; aim for an A1C of 7% or lower; and reduce body-wide inflammation with a healthy plantbased diet.

For help controlling blood pressure, check out "5 Supplements" to Support Heart Health and Blood Pressure" at iHerb.com/ blog and the information on Inspiratory Resistance Training (it's as effective as blood pressure medication) in "The Great Age Reboot."


